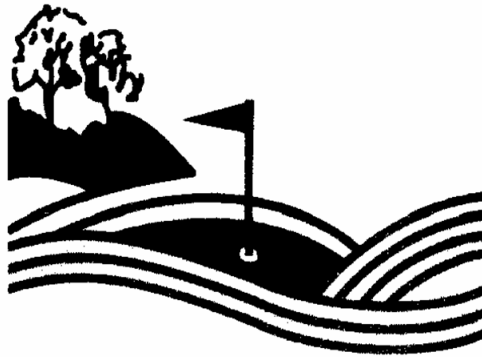

CLUB HISTORY

1908 - The Clare Golf Club was founded and is now one of the oldest golf clubs in S.A. The first course covered land now occupied by Lake Inchiquin and the Housing Trust Estate. Some of the holes used then still exist as part of the present course layout. The first clubhouse was located just across the road from the hospital. This was probably no accident as the story is that two keen golfing doctors were instrumental in the early growth of the club.

1957 - The Club commenced again after inactivity just prior to World War II. Meanwhile, a number of small clubs had developed in Water-vale, Blyth and Farrell Flat.

1958 - A new course was laid out around the old racecourse and show grounds south of Clare.

1978 - The current site was purchased including some of the land that made up the original course.

1990 - Greens were installed.

1991 - 1st Club Championships played on the greens

1994 - The adjacent *Clare Country Club* was opened and has proven to be an asset for the Club by attracting golfers from around S.A. and interstate and overseas visitors.

2008 - Celebration of 100 yrs of golf in the Clare Valley.

The course and greens of the Club are now well recognized as one of the best country courses in the state.

The course plays 5899 metres (Men's) and 5142 metres (Ladies). Par is 72. ACR is 72. AWCR 72.

The lowest official score by an amateur or professional is **68** and is shared by Paul Pridham (2010) ,John Nairn (2012) ,Tim Jenkins (2015) and Jarrad Steele (2016)

The lowest official score by an amateur or professional women is **73** which was set by Ebony Heard in 2008.

ETIQUETTE

1. No one should move, talk or stand close to, or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
2. The player who has the honor should be allowed to play before his opponent, or fellow competitor, however the CGC encourages ready golf
3. No player should play until the players in front are out of range.
4. In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
5. Players searching for a ball should signal the players behind to pass as soon as it is apparent the ball will not be found easily.
6. Through the green, players should ensure any turf cut or displaced is repaired by using sand carried in a bucket. Damage to the putting green made by a ball (pitch marks) must be carefully repaired. Damage caused by shoe spikes should be repaired on completion of the hole.
7. Players should ensure that, when putting down bags or the flagstick, no damage is done to the putting green and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to it, in handling the flagstick or in removing the ball from the hole. Players should not damage the putting green by leaning on their putters, particularly when removing the ball from the hole.
When the play of the hole has been completed, players should leave the green immediately. Marking of cards should not delay play.

CHANGE OF MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY DURING THE YEAR

- An application in writing must be made to the Management Committee. The change will apply from the date of ratification by that committee.
- The member will pay the difference between the two fees irrespective of the time of the year.

NEW MEMBERS

It is every Members responsibility to welcome new members and help them to become part of our club.

Players should know the basic rules of golf before entering any competition.

MEN'S COMPETITIONS

Tee times: 7.30am to 8.00am and 11.30am to 1.00pm

Players may tee off outside of these times, however, you must arrange somebody to play with and book a time in the Pro Shop.

Players wishing to play early on Saturday morning, without arranging others to play with, should be on the tee by 7.30am, to ensure they get a game. 1pm is the latest tee time allowed.

Motorized carts may be used in all competitions

HANDICAPPING

Members must return all competition cards to the Captain or handicapper by no later than 5.45pm to enable results to be entered into Golf Link and the Sunday Mail. Members are responsible to check handicaps from the board each week and can check any time on the Golf Link web site.

CLUB COMPETITIONS

All competitions are under the control of the Match Committee which reserves the right to change, alter the date, cancel or vary any competition. On days when competitions arranged by the Match Committee are in progress, any member or visitor not taking part may only play when and where directed by the Golf Professional or his nominated assistant.

PRACTICE BEFORE COMPETITIONS

The area between the front of the first tee block and the creek on the first fairway is the only area to be used for practice hitting on competition days. Rule 7-1b applies.

Putting practice is restricted to the practice putting greens only.

Chipping practice is restricted to the practice chipping green or areas designated by the Head Green keeper

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS (Stroke Match Play)

4 stroke qualifying rounds, the aggregate of the 2 lowest gross scores will determine match play order. The top 8 qualifiers in each grade will play stroke match play. In the event of ties a count back will be done on the last counting round.

Any player can contest to be Club Champion, otherwise a player starting qualifying in a particular grade will stay in that grade.

A, B C grades based on handicap as at 29th July. Quarter and semi finals played on same day, 18 holes in the morning and afternoon

MONTHLY MEDAL

A Stroke round played on the 1st Saturday of each month throughout the year. Incorporating the Matt Davoren Chimney Sweep putting competition

If the club pennants clash with this event, another date will be scheduled

ECLECTIC - separate winter and summer competitions

Best stroke score on all holes in Saturday competitions over winter and summer. Handicap is half of playing handicap on the last day of each season.

ECLECTIC (Stableford) - sponsored by Phil Bryant

HOLE IN ONE

A hole in one is recognized on the honor board when it is achieved in any paid Clare Golf Club Inc. and Pro Shop weekly competitions. The player must hold an official GA handicap, however sponsors prizes are for specific competitions only

LADIES COMPETITIONS

Captain and Match Committee have complete control of play.

WEDNESDAY WINTER COMPETITIONS

Cards in by **9.15am** to start the draw.

Starting time at the direction of the committee.

Time sheet draw for Club Championship finals rounds.

Handicaps must be checked on the sheet each week. Daily handicaps should be listed on cards and can be checked on the Golf Link website at any time.

CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS

Qualifying rounds - aggregate of 2 lowest gross scores used over the 3 rounds programmed. To be played in grades.

In the event of a tie a count back to be done on the lowest 18 hole round. A player starting in a particular grade will continue in that grade throughout the championship regardless of handicap change. Exception: A player from any grade has the option to qualify and contest the A Grade Championship.

In case of inclement weather on any day of quarter and semi finals, the Match Committee reserves the right to defer play to another day of the same week. In case of no play on the final day on May 31, play will be deferred to Wed June 7. All above dates can be altered at the discretion of the Match Committee. Final tee times from 8.30am.

A Grade - 36 holes, B Grade - 27 holes, C Grade - 18 holes.

Grades to be decided by the Match Committee .
