Ladies Competition Guidelines:

LADIES COMPETITIONS

Captain and Match Committee have complete control of play.

WEDNESDAY WINTER COMPETITIONS

Cards in by 9.15am for 9.30 tee off

9 hole competition. Cards in by 10.15am for 10.30am tee off

Tee time sheet to be drawn up for Club Championship finals

Handicaps must be checked each week. Daily handicaps must be listed on cards

CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS

Qualifying rounds - aggregate of 2 lowest gross scores used over the 3 rounds programmed. To be played in approximate grades

In the event of a tie a count back to be done on the lowest 18 hole round. Exception: A player from any grade has the option to qualify and contest the A Grade Championship.

In case of inclement weather on any day of quarter and semi finals, the Match Committee reserves the right to defer play to another day of the same week. In case of no play on the final day on 20 June, play will be deferred to Wed 27 June. All above dates can be altered at the discretion of the Match Committee. Final tee times from 8.30am.

A Grade - 36 holes, B Grade - 27 holes, C Grade - 18 holes.

Grades to be decided by the Match Committee .

Aggregate of 4 lowest net scores from 18 hole stroke rounds

STABLEFORD TROPHY

Aggregate of best 4 stableford rounds.

PAR TROPHY

Aggregate of 3 best par rounds.

JOY CHAPMAN TROPHY (65+)

Donor: Life Member Julianne Smith

Aggregate of 4 highest stableford rounds.

LADIES CLUB CANADIAN FOURSOMES

Donor R & B Sutherland Jewellers by Design

A draw will be conducted on the day. Gross and net winners. Same pair not eligible to win both events

CLARE CLUB TROPHY

Donors: Patrons Bev Sanders and Gypsy Sandow

Played over 3 consecutive rounds, par, stroke and stableford. Points awarded to the five best scores of each round; i.e.9,7,5,3,1 In the event of a tie, points awarded (as above) over the 3 cards of players tied.

ECLECTIC COMPETITION—(Net event)

Handicap manager responsible for recording first round on eclectic cards. Players to record their scores for the winter season.

HANDICAP CONSISTENCY AWARD - donor Clare Golf Centre Trophy

A perpetual trophy presented to the player playing most consistently to her handicap including all club competitions, open days and State events during the winter season.

9 HOLE WINTER TROPHY

Points awarded over all rounds on a 3,2,1 basis

NOTE –All trophies will be decided on a count back.

SUMMER GOLF

Tee Times: Before Christmas - 8.30 am After Christmas - 8am.

Players may play earlier if a playing partner is arranged
